Capitalism and altruism will collaborate in a genuine case of communities taking care of their own on Tuesday, November 11, 2008. Participating Triangle restaurants will donate 10% of their gross proceeds to help feed our hungry residents. Beneficiaries are Inter-faith Council for Social Service (Chapel Hill-Carrboro), The Food Bank of Central and Eastern North Carolina (Wake County), and locally, Urban Ministries of Durham's Community Kitchen.

The Rev. Julia Webb Bowden of Urban Ministries expects the event to garner about \$15,000, which will help provide hungry Durham residents with 450-500 meals a day, served 3 times a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Primarily involving local restaurants (versus chains), participation from first-timers is up about 10% this year. Participating restaurants sport a brightly colored poster in their windows with the caption "Dine Out and Make a Difference." The Landist News is proud of our distribution partners who support this life-changing endeavor: Elmo's Diner, Rue Cler Cafe, and Toast Panioteca.



Toast Panioteca owners Kelly and Billy Cotter have long worked for restaurants who took part in RSVVP and are excited to be participating on their own for the first time this year. Open only since February, they are committed to giving back to the Durham community, which has so warmly embraced their new endeavor.




